The building measures over 4,000 square feet and will be used to train our clients in daily life skills including: household chores (cleaning, laundry, kitchen), computer skills, exercise techniques, arts and crafts and music.

ARC serves over 160 intellectually and developmentally disabled clients in our ADT program daily.

Currently six clients work at various employers in Marion County with the assistance of ARC.

ARC serves over 60 children from birth to age three over the course of a school year.

Our staff has over 655 years of combined service at ARC with the average tenure of 6.5 years.

ARC provides and manages group home housing (24/7/365) for 22 individuals.

ARC clients travel in group enclaves to employers in the community. Transportation and supervision provided by ARC.

Approximately 160 ARC clients get paid weekly for contract work supplied by local Ocala businesses.

ADT clients develop goals they would like to accomplish on an annual basis with ARC staff...

(and they accomplish them too!!!)

Medicaid Waiver funding has decreased by 13% over the past eight years, while our service to clients has not decreased.
